The programme of talks

- Catchy and non-technical talks able to raise visitors' interest in Space technologies
- Concrete applications of remote sensing techniques (climate change monitoring, emergency management, urban planning, energy...) or satellite navigation signals (aviation, agriculture, transport...)
- Ideally, a short introduction about European Space programmes (Copernicus, Galileo, EGNOS) should be included
- At least 3 talks every day (usually at 5:30pm, 6:00pm and 6:30pm)
- A standard template for the presentation will be provided
